

# California is facing a \$16 billion budget shortfall



Who in OC will be affected by the Governor's proposal of 10% Cuts?

- c **10,130** low income children in 2008-2009 and a total of 18,450 children by 2009-2010 who would lose Medi-Cal coverage due to increased requirements
- c **368,080** low-income Medi-Cal recipients who may have reduced access to healthcare services due to payment cuts to health providers
- c **89,120** children enrolled in Healthy Families Program (low cost healthcare for low-income working families) would have increased family premiums, increased co-pays, and reduced dental services.
- c **7,180** Low income children dropped from the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids Program
- c **69,080** low-income seniors and persons with disabilities who would lose the state Cost-Of-Living Adjustment for Supplemental Security Income. (State Supplemental Cash Assistance Grants).
- c **13,560** homebound seniors and disabled will receive a reduction in hours in-home care.
- c Education cuts equivalent to **\$595** dollars per student in Orange County.
- c **930** fewer children enrolled in childcare and preschool due to cuts in programs
